Grand Canyon West Welcomes Summer Visitors with Packaged Experiences

Ticketed options include dining, rafting, and more.

PEACH SPRINGS, AZ, May 3, 2021 – As travelers gear up to hit the road for the summer season, the Grand Canyon Resort Corporation is excited to safely welcome visitors to the region with a variety of ticket packages to experience the Grand Canyon like never before.

Located just two hours from Las Vegas on the west rim of the canyon, <u>Grand Canyon West</u> offers unique experiences to take in one of the seven natural wonders of the world by foot, air, and boat. The property is located on the Hualapai Native American Reservation and is owned and operated by the <u>Hualapai Tribe</u>.

Guests can <u>explore the area</u> via rafting on the Colorado River with the Hualapai River Runners, soaring on the Zipline at Grand Canyon West, and taking in unforgettable views on the Grand Canyon Skywalk—a 10-foot wide, horseshoe-shaped glass bridge that extends 70 feet out over the rim of the Grand Canyon giving guests a clear view 4,000 feet to the floor of the Canyon below. For an even more dramatic aerial view, guests can soar above the canyon on a helicopter tour for a true bird's eye view. A variety of ticketed experiences are available, including seasonal specials.

"Guests can expect full compliance with safety guidelines while on-site as they explore one of the world's most famous locations in unexpected ways."

- **Grandest Package:** Includes general admission, access to the Skywalk, a helicopter tour, and pontoon boat experience for \$278.
- Grandiose Package: Includes a one-day Hualapai River Runners rafting trip for \$360,

with the option to add-on overnight stays at the Hualapai Lodge (additional fees will apply).

To complete the experience, visitors can stay on-site at the rustic cabins of Grand Canyon West or opt for accommodations available at the Hualapai Lodge, located along historic Rt. 66.
